**SEQUENCES AND SERIES:** ARITHMETIC AND GEOMETRIC SEQUENCES AND SERIES, FINDING SUMS AND TERMS. THE ALGEBRA 2 REGENTS JUNE 2016 OFTEN INCLUDED QUESTIONS ON RECURSIVE FORMULAS AND EXPLICIT FORMULAS FOR SEQUENCES.

**STATISTICS:** ANALYZING DATA, INTERPRETING STATISTICAL MEASURES, AND UNDERSTANDING PROBABILITY DISTRIBUTIONS. THE
