THE USE OF VIBRANT COLORS, APPEALING IMAGERY, AND VARIED ACTIVITIES CAN ENHANCE ENGAGEMENT AND MAINTAIN CHILDREN’S INTEREST. FURTHERMORE, INCORPORATING REAL-WORLD OBJECTS OR SCENARIOS CAN MAKE THE LEARNING PROCESS MORE RELATABLE AND MEANINGFUL. CONSIDER USING THEMES THAT RESONATE WITH CHILDREN’S INTERESTS, SUCH AS ANIMALS, VEHICLES, OR FOOD.

H4: INTEGRATING ALIKE AND DIFFERENT WORKSHEETS INTO THE CURRICULUM
