DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS: SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS AND CONSTRAINTS RELATED TO DESIGN STYLE, BRANDING GUIDELINES, TECHNICAL LIMITATIONS, AND PLATFORM SPECIFICATIONS.

TIMELINE AND BUDGET: REALISTIC TIMELINES AND BUDGET ALLOCATIONS TO ENSURE PROJECT FEASIBILITY.

DELIVERABLES: A DETAILED LIST OF THE EXPECTED OUTPUTS FROM THE PROJECT.
