Hence there is no person who visits his grave except that I receive him, and there is no Muslim who offers salutations to him or who prays for him except that I take it to his presence and carry his message. Saying this Fitrus flew away. In another narrative, it is related that Fitrus flew away saying, Who is similar to me? For I am a freed one of Husain (s.a.s), the son of Ali (a.s) and Fatemah (a.s), whose Grandfather is Ahmed (s.a.w.s).
