Note that the purpose of this book is not to teach people about behavioral science; there are many other books out there for those purposes. That said, *Inside Nudging* introduces some behavioral science concepts to provide context and help develop a common language between management professionals and scientists. I see the application of behavioral science as still being in the early adoption phase. Many companies will benefit if they take time to develop the right approach.
