ANSWER: FALSE. WHILE THE PREMISES ARE TRUE, THE CONCLUSION IS INVALID. NOT ALL BIRDS THAT HAVE FEATHERS CAN FLY. THIS DEMONSTRATES A COMMON PITFALL: JUMPING TO CONCLUSIONS WITHOUT CONSIDERING ALL POSSIBLE SCENARIOS. A COMPLETE "2 4 PRACTICE DEDUCTIVE REASONING ANSWER KEY" WILL HIGHLIGHT THE FLAW IN THE ARGUMENT.
